The Canadian government released an action plan, "Immigrant, Refugee and Ethnic Affairs: The Strategy for the 21st Century," outlining a series of re-organization and integration initiatives intended to "assist newcomers and for better or for ill, to ensure that the immigrant population in Canada is able to contribute to the country's growth and prosperity." The plan also includes a commitment to "ensure that the Canadian government will take steps to address the needs, discrimination and the rights of indigenous peoples" as it develops full citizenship with "Canada's indigenous peoples and First Nations." The plan also states that the government will "not adopt the perspective that was passed by the majority of members of the job-department Assembly in 2000."
