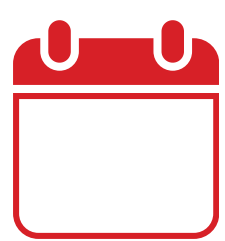

Academic freedom, vital to our ability to educate students and advance knowledge, is symbolically embraced across Canada yet becoming increasingly precarious for all academic staff.

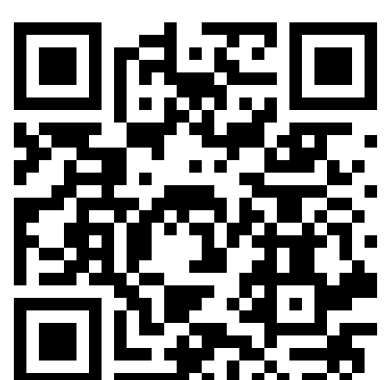

Dr. James Turk is the Director of the Centre for Free Expression (CFE) at Toronto Metropolitan University.

Prior to founding and leading CFE, Jim Turk was Executive Director of the Canadian Association of University Teachers from 1998 to 2014. Previously, he was Associate Professor of Sociology at the University of Toronto where he taught Canadian Studies and headed the Labour Studies Program at University College. He has also held several senior positions in the Canadian trade union movement.

Jim speaks and writes extensively on academic freedom, freedom of expression and its relation to social justice, human rights, civil liberties, and the challenges of democracy in an illiberal age.

He has a Ph.D. from the University of Toronto, a M.A. from the University of California at Berkeley, an A.B. from Harvard University, and was a Knox Fellow at the University of Cambridge.
